

Important – please read carefully:

Membership Conditions

- Membership is held on a monthly basis and runs from the first day to the last day of the month.
- All members must have current BHPA membership and qualifications.
- You must book in for your flying via our online booking system. You cannot just turn up and expect to fly.
- Membership payments must be paid on the first day of each month by standing order.
- If membership is cancelled or ceases due to non-payment for longer than one month, the joining fee will have to be paid again.
- All pilots should have their own Tow Release and Radio. These can be hired for £5.00 each per day if you haven't purchased your own yet (and must be signed for). If a loan unit is lost or damaged you will be expected to pay for a replacement.

Safety Issues

- Part of our agreement with the military and CAA that allows us to fly within Salisbury danger area is that ALL PILOTS will be on radio at ALL TIMES. This is so we can quickly ground everyone if there is any fast jet, helicopter or large aircraft heading our way. We often have live firing going on while we're flying too.
- All pilots must fly with a recently re-packed reserve parachute.
- Only certified gliders, tow releases, tow attachments and ParAvion weak links will be used.
- No pilot will be allowed to fly without a ParAvion weak link.
- If we consider your glider or equipment not airworthy, we reserve the right to refuse towing it until we have seen a current inspection report.
- It is your responsibility to check that your glider is suitable for towing (this will be stated in the owner's manual).

Club Rules

- **NO SMOKING in the tow field.** We have had too many holes put in gliders by smokers leaving lit cigarette ends on the ground where people put their kit. If you smoke, please be considerate of others' property (and health) and move right to the edge of the field.
- No children or dogs will be permitted on site unless by special arrangement with the Duty Instructor or Senior Tow Coach. Both must be kept under strict control with dogs kept on leads well away from the launch area.
- Flying fees will be £2.50 per tow with a minimum daily rate of £10.00.
- All tow fees are to be paid (in cash) to the Duty Instructor or Senior Tow Coach at the end of the day's flying. If you fly XC, they can be paid by dropping them through the Pewsey office letterbox (in a sealed envelope with ParAvion written on it) that evening or ASAP.
- Parking is limited. It is important that you only park in designated areas. One selfishly parked car causing an access problem for farm vehicles could easily lose us a flying site.
- A flight order list will be kept by the Launch Marshal. Once you have flown, your name will go to the bottom of the list. On XC days a separate list may be kept for those wishing to fly XC. During the best time to get away (1130 to 1330) XC pilots may jump the queue (within reason) to help improve their chances.
- Our tow sites are not to be used under any circumstances for any reason unless a member of ParAvion staff is present.
- All ParAvion equipment is to remain within the tow field. If you want to fly XC, you must use your own.
- Any member not obeying these few simple rules may have their membership revoked or suspended.
